- A no personal device policy for educators to support presence and reduce child exposure
- A newly appointed Labour Lead overseeing rosters and safe supervision across all centres
- Automated compliance checks for new employees to improve accuracy and reduce manual error
- A new Safety section on our website outlining our approach and providing families with the opportunity to share anonymous feedback

What Is Coming Next

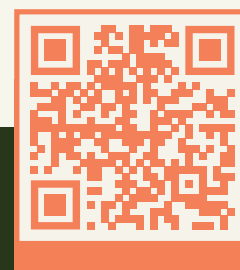
- Safety Scorecard giving Centre Managers visibility over key safety metrics such as team training and family sign in accuracy
